“And one cried to another, and said, Holy, holy, holy, is the Lord of hosts: the whole earth is full of His glory.”

(Isaiah 6:3; Revelation 4:8)

In our observation of the scriptures there is no question of the plurality of the characteristic of the God of the Holy Writ. For as it is stated in the title, the angelic creation of our Almighty God has declared “Holy, holy, holy” is the Lord of hosts. Isn’t it interesting that they were commanded to proclaim a thrice Holy attribute of the Lord of host? For as we are revealed that in the creation of all things as recorded in Genesis 1:26 “And God said, Let “US” (plural) make man in “OUR” image, after “OUR” likeness,” revealing that God the Father had His pre-existent Son as the actual creator of ALL things whatsoever was made. For Christ merely SPOKE all things into existence by the power of His word (Colo 1:16, John 1: 1-3).

For this very Christ, the Son of the Almighty was the “WORD which became flesh and dwelt among us full of grace and truth” (John 1:14). For this very Godman Christ Jesus commanded his beloved chosen disciples to go forth to preach and teach the gospel to men whatsoever Christ had taught them baptizing them which believed in the “name of the FATHER, and of the SON, and of the HOLY GHOST” (Matt. 28:19). Here we find that Christ had revealed this “plurality” of the Godhead in THREE aspects. As our title determines a thrice Holy God, we see where the FATHER, the SON, and the HOLY GHOST are without question HOLY in their designated aspects in the sovereign character of the Lord God Almighty.

For this thrice-Holy concept of the FATHER, the SON, and the HOLY GHOST is without discrimination between each aspect of Gods character. The Son is no less holy than that of the Father, and the Holy Ghost is no less holy than that of the Son, for they are EQUAL in holiness. For this is a great mystery that men have attempted by many means and methods to explain and define this infinite divine truth. The earliest of theologians have called this scriptural concept of God as the TRINITY of which is NOT a scriptural term. Yet the God of the scriptures is a TRIUNE GOD, three in one, if you

please. For the beloved apostle penned regarding Christ, "Who being in the form of God, thought it not robbery to be equal with God" (Phil.2:6).

Oh! to now be revealed why the seraphim of God cried out, "Holy, holy, holy is the Lord of hosts!! For in these last days God in the revelation of the New Testament, New Covenant has manifested by his word this thrice Holy God of which the Holy scriptures references. The apostle John in his writings stated the following, "Who is He that overcometh the world, but he that believeth that Jesus is the Son of God? This is He that came by water and by blood, (Editor's note: IMHO this WATER and BLOOD is the description of the natural birth of Christ's physical body, not a water baptism, as some would speculate, in John 3:5), even Jesus Christ; not by WATER only (natural birth) but by WATER and BLOOD. And it is the Spirit that beareth witness, because the Spirit is truth. For these are THREE (triune) that bear record in heaven, the FATHER, the WORD (Son), and the Holy Ghost: AND THESE THREE ARE ONE. And there are THREE that beareth witness in earth, the Spirit, and the water, and the blood: AND THESE THREE AGREE IN ONE" (I John 5: 5-8).

We find the again in the book of the Revelation of Jesus Christ where John had described the angelic creatures of God at His throne as follows, "And before the throne there was a sea of glass like unto crystal: and in the midst of the throne, and around about the throne, were four beasts (seraphim) full of eyes before and behind. And the first beast was like a lion, and the second beast like a calf, and the third beast had a face as a man, and the fourth beast was like a flying eagle. And the four beast had each of them six wings about him; and they were full of eyes within: and they rest not day and night, saying, Holy, holy, holy, Lord God almighty, which was, and is, and is to come" (Rev. 4: 6-8).

Our thrice-Holy God of which the scriptures declare is summed up in the person of our LORD JESUS CHRIST, God manifested in the flesh, the fullness of the Godhead bodily revealed to the heirs of grace by the means of Gods Holy Spirit by which the elect of God shall be born again to SEE and to ENTER into the kingdom of Gods dear Son and experience salvation so rich and so free.

For we of the New Covenant are taught that JESUS CHRIST is the only means of which unholy mankind can have access to Gods throne of grace to pray for help in the time of need. For CHRIST is our perpetual High Priest which continually makes intercession for we which are blessed to believe that Christ died for our sin and has paid the ultimate price with his Holy BLOOD redeeming us unto himself by His vicarious sacrificial love and sovereign mercy; to whom be praise, honor and glory forever without end.
